EXODUS

GOD'S LOVE - 3 Attacks by Pharaoh Ex.1:1f

Pharaoh feared they had become too numerous and were a threat 1:10

- 1. Increase workload on the men.
- 2. Have mid wives kill the baby boys.
- 3. Throw the baby boys into the Nile

God 's LOVE is when the people cry out, God listens. Ex.2:23 God is listening.

GOD'S JOY - 10 Similarities of Moses Life Ex.2:1f

3 Similarities to Jesus:

- 1. Killing of baby boys by Pharaoh / by Herod. Mt.2:16
- Watched over by sister / by angels.Mt.4:6; Mk.1:13; Lk.22:43; Lk.24:4f; Jn.20:6-8?
- 3. Saved by Pharaoh's daughter / by money from Magi. Mt.2:11-15

3 Similarities to Abraham:

- 1. Educated by Gentiles in Egypt Ac.7:22 / in Ur. Gen.11:31
- 2. Saved life of an Israelite / saved Lot. Gen.14:14-16
- 3. Became enemy of Pharaoh by killing an Egyptian / by lying. Gen.12:17-20;

3 Similarities to Jacob:

- 1. Fled for his life from Pharaoh / fled from Esau. Gen.27:41f
- 2. Found his wife at a well Zipporah / Rachel. Gen.29:1f
- 3. Had children while they sojourned in wilderness. Ex.2:22; Gen.47:9

10. All four became Shepherds at the end of their lives

Ac.7:22-25 It entered Moses' mind to visit Israelites vs.23 – sent by God? But took vengeance, Ro.12:19; He supposed the people would see him as a deliverer sent by God vs.25 why? Because God sent him to visit not vengeance!

God's JOY is preparing Moses to save His people.

GOD'S PEACE - 1 Picture of the Burning Bush Ex.3:1f

- 1. The bush represents the people of God Ps.1:3; The Israelites
- 2. Fire represents persecution from Egyptians.
- 3. The voice represents God living in us.

Moses was powerful in word and deed Ac.7:22-24; but no more, He was humbled by God, by spending 40 yrs learning to be a shepherd, Jn.21:15-17

Almost killed by God for not circumcising his son, all leaders must fully obey, 4:24-26 Zipporah knew to circumcise, from Midianites – Abraham's 2nd wife, Keturah Gen.25:4 Her father, Jethro a priest to God Ex.18:10-12; Balaam Num.22:1f; Melchizedek Gen.12:18f

GOD'S PEACE – God wants a relationship with His people, so He is sending them Moses.

GOD'S PATIENCE – 3 Miracles by Aaron Ex.4:27-31

Aaron used these 3 signs to prove Moses was sent by God.

- 1. Throw your staff to the ground, it turned into a serpent.4:3
- 2. Put your hand in your coat, came out leprous, back, came out cured. 4:6
- 3. Pour water out of a pitcher, it turned into blood 4:9

GOD'S PATIENCE - is seen by providing a new way after Moses refused to talk, 4:14

GOD'S KINDNESS – 10 PLAGUES Ex.5-12

- Water to blood, Ex.7:14-25; tell Pharaoh in AM, Aaron stretch out your staff. Magicians repeated with secret arts, Vs.22 Jesus changes water to wine, Jn.2:1-11; 1st miracle, Jesus EMPOWERS, giving us the HS making a Living Word, Jn.7:37-39; 1Cor.2:12
- Frogs over the land, Ex.8:1-7; tell Pharaoh,
 Aaron stretch out your staff. Magicians repeated with secret arts Vs.7
 Jesus casts out demons, Mk.1:27; Rev.16:13-14
 Jesus DELIVERED us from Satan, Heb.2:14,15; Rev.12:10-12; 16:20; 20:1-3
- Gnats, sand flies, tiny stinging insect Ex.8:16-19
 Aaron stretch out your staff. Magicians could not the finger of God. Vs.18,19.

 No flies will enter Goshen,

 No pestilence in Goshen.

GOD'S KINDNESS - is convincing Pharaoh to let His people go, glorifying Himself. Ex.10:2;

GOD'S GOODNESS - 1 PICTURE - PARTING OF THE RED SEA Ex.13-14

1Cor.10:1-5 They were baptized into Moses, we are baptized into Christ Gal.3:27

The enemy perished in the water, the Egyptians, our sins and old man. Ro.6:3-7

GOD'S GOODNESS is seen in delivering us from the enemy.

GOD'S FAITHFULNESS – 3 PROVISIONS Ex.16-17; Mt.6:25

Israel had 603,550 men – double for wives, add children and old people, 2.5 million

The wilderness could not supply this many people, especially for 40 yrs, but God did.

God supplies quail and manna Ex.16:8

God supplies fresh water Ex.17:6; 1Cor.10:4

God supplies protection, light at night, pillar of cloud in day, Ex.13:21

GOD'S FAITHFULNESS – seen in providing His people what they need.

GOD'S GENTLENESS – 10 COMMANDMENTS Ex.20:1-17

Love the Lord your God with all your: Mk.12:29-31

Heart – God is omniscient, all knowing - so have no other gods

This frees us from having to investigate all world/other religions, Eph.4:4-6

Soul – God is omnipresent, all everywhere – have/make no images.

This places God in your soul, not in a building, Ac.17:22-31; Ro.8:9-11

Mind – God is omnipotent, all powerful, do not use His name in vain,

Do not promote evil activity in His name, need to use your brain, Mt.10:16

Strength – God is omnibenevolent – all caring - keep the Sabbath holy

God cares for our well being, you need a day of rest, Heb.4:9-10

Love Your Neighbor: these next 3 sins effect those around you.

Honor your mother and father – Eph.6:1-3 Learn to respect authority.

Failing here makes one a detriment to society, no respect of law and order, Ro.13:1f

Do not murder – Mt.5:21-26 not even have hate in your heart, failing this puts you on the brink

of uncontrolled sinful behaviors, Jm.1:14-15

Do not commit adultery – Mt.5:27-32; do not violate your vows or another's.



1. Outer Court, 2. Holy Place, 3. Holy of Holies

3 Things in the *Outer Court*

- **4.** The Gate for the Outer Court, Ex.27:16; Here people offered their sacrifices Lev.1:2-9;
- **5.** Altar of burnt offerings: Ex.27:1-8; Here priests offer up to God the sacrifices, Lev.1:9
- **6.** Laver: Ex.30:18-20; Here priests cleansed themselves,

3 Things in the Holy Place

- **7.** Table of Shewbread: Ex.25:23-30;
 The bread represents people of God, Lev.24:5-9;
- **8.** Lampstand: Ex.25:31-40; Burned continually Lev.24:2;
- **9.** Altar of Incense prayers of people Ex.30:1-10 Separating curtain
 - **10.** The Veil: Ex.26:31-35 3 colors blue, purple, and scarlet

11. Ark of the Covenant




